TO SACRIFICE FOR OTHERS

Brothers, as we approach another Memorial Day, let us remember and honor the sacrifices that the men and women of the armed forces have made on our behalf. The Tsali Lodge has a rich history of service and dedication to the community and the nation. Several of its members have served in the armed forces, and some have given their lives in the line of duty. Their bravery and selflessness are a testament to the values of the Scouting movement, embodying the principles of honor, duty, and sacrifice. Their contributions to our country ensure that we continue to enjoy the freedoms we hold dear today.

I would like to remember and honor the sacrifices of Marshall Gravatt, Jr. and Rex W. Muse.

Lt. Gravatt was born in 1921 in Asheville, N.C. He was a dedicated Boy Scout and a member of Troop 8 in Asheville. He also served as a staff member at Camp Daniel Boone, both when it was located at Old Fort and after it moved to its current location. In 1941, Mr. Gravatt became the first waterfront director when the camp opened in Canton. In 1938, Marshall Gravatt was selected as one of 31 nominees for induction into the newly formed Tsali Lodge, Order of the Arrow. He was subsequently elected Lodge Chief, a role he held for 3 years, demonstrating his leadership and commitment to scouting.

In 1942, Marshall Gravatt joined the Army Air Corps. He was selected to be a pilot and was sent for training in South Carolina. Tragically, he was killed during a routine flight in a P-38 fighter near Boco Grande, Florida on August 14, 1943 at the age of 21. His funeral service was held August 17, 1943 at Riverside Cemetery in Asheville, where members of Tsali Lodge formed a guard of honor to pay their respects. Lt. Gravatt's life and service are a profound reminder of the sacrifices made by members of the Scouting community and the armed forces for our freedom.
